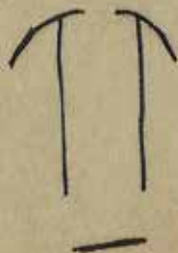


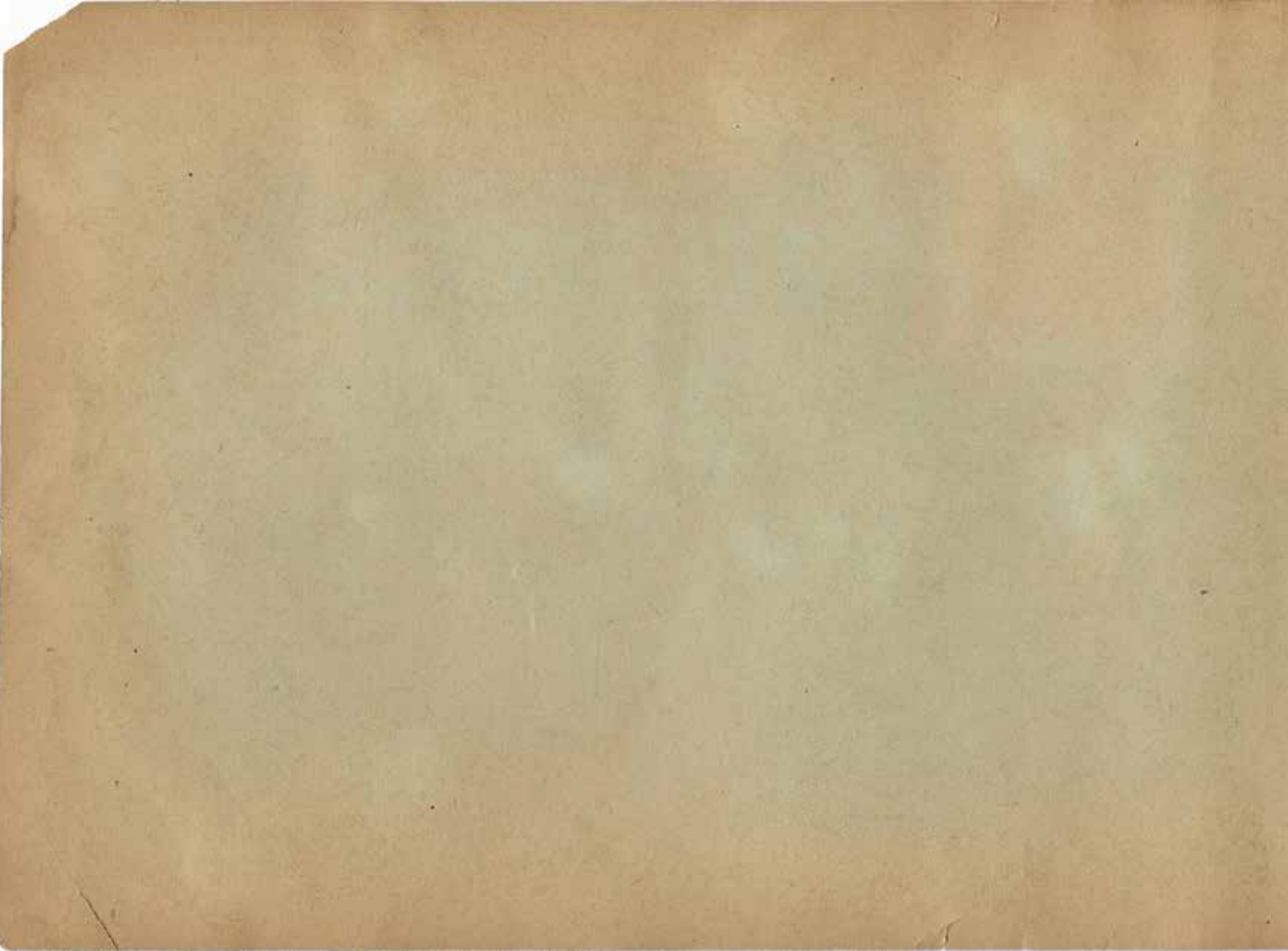

A G R E E M E N T
